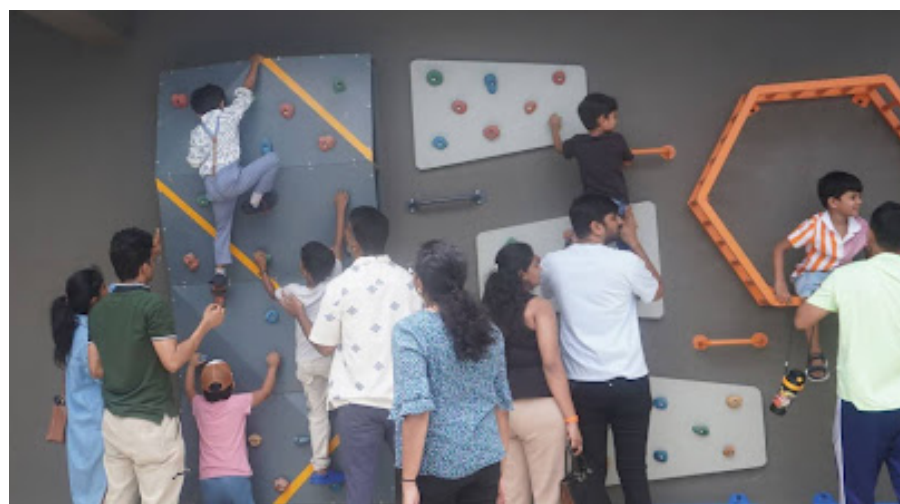


CULTURE AT THE CAMPUS

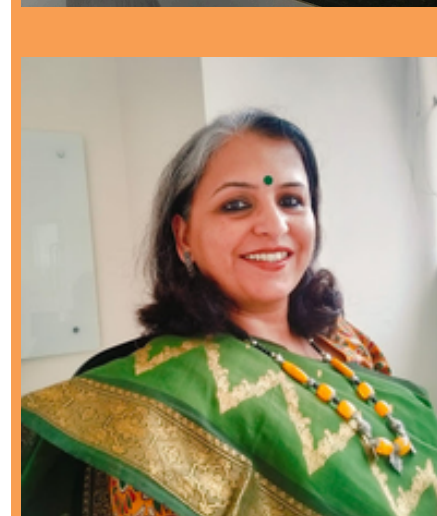
